

Homework & Presentation Award (HPA) Criteria

Award Rating

- Outstanding effort – Classroom display standard **R3**
 - Actively sought out how to make improvements – Growth Mind-set
 - Undertaken further research independently to enhance the work
 - Excellent understanding of the objective is shown
 - Provided in depth, concise answers/explanations
 - Outstanding presentation of work
 - Spelling, grammar and/or numeracy are at a very high standard
- Good effort with some evidence of independent learning **R2**
 - Presentation is good but opportunities are missed to enhance the work
 - A good understanding of the objective is evident
 - Spelling, grammar and/or numeracy is good but requires TRAFFIC
- Effort has been clearly made, although there are elements which need addressing
 - Presentation of work requires more effort and care in some parts
 - Some evidence of understanding of the objective although this requires TRAFFIC
 - Spelling, grammar and/or numeracy is generally ok but requires TRAFFIC **R1**
- Some effort has been made, however, this is still below school expectations
 - Presentation of work shows little care and lacks pride
 - There is little evidence to suggest any progress has been made
 - There are careless errors and mistakes with spellings, grammar and/or numeracy
- Extremely poor effort – Incomplete homework – Numerous errors throughout
 - No pride or concern for presentation of work
 - No progress evident – Fixed Mind-set
